Background and discussion topics

Nature-based solutions (NbS) involve working with nature to address societal challenges, including climate change adaptation. Although evidence for the effectiveness of NbS for adaptation is growing, there is relatively less evidence on whether and how NbS reduces vulnerability to climate change in the Global South, which houses a large proportion of the world's most climate-vulnerable people. For example, although Bangladesh leads in adopting ecosystem-based approaches for human well-being and biodiversity benefits, documented evidence has been lacking. In this session, we will discuss the evidence available on NbS for climate change adaptation in the Global South and Bangladesh and how NbS have potential to address short-term and long-term economic recovery. The session will highlight policy actions to scale-up NbS and facilitate their effective and inclusive delivery in the Global South.

Expected outcome

As Nature-based Solutions (NbS) is a major agenda in COP26, we hope to hear from researchers, practitioners and policymakers across the world working on NbS. During our session, we would like to gather messages to strengthen the knowledge base and scale-up NbS across policy and practice to address the climate crisis and biodiversity loss for human wellbeing.
